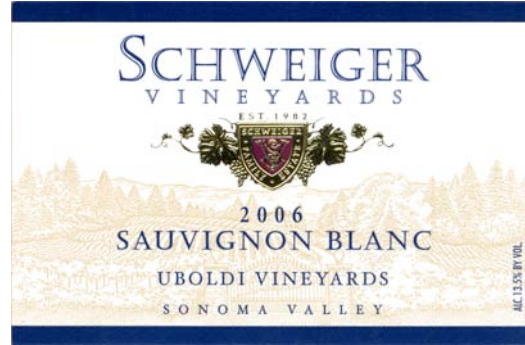
★★★★★ 93 points – 2004 Schweiger Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon – Great nose; rich with red fruit flavors and a beautiful finish; one of the best. –Beverage Dynamics. 3,550 cases produced, all estate fruit.



The Chardonnay fruit is exclusively from the estate with no malolactic fermentation and only 26% new oak barrels used with the majority all neutral oak. 800cs. produced.



★★★★★ 93 points – 2004 Schweiger Vineyards Merlot From high atop Spring Mountain, comes this amazing merlot; big, full rich fruit, with an elegant creamy finish; great now; can't wait to taste it again after 3-5 years of cellaring. – Beverage Dynamics
This is a “Cabernet drinker's” style of Merlot. It is 100% Merlot fruit from the estate with only 385 cs. produced.



This is barrel fermented from fruit off Uboldi Vineyards in Kenwood. Aged surlies for 4 months. Screw cap closure with 990 cs. produced.





- In 1960, Fred Schweiger's parents, Tony and Theresa Schweiger, purchased 53 acres on Spring Mountain. In 1961, Fred purchased an additional eight acres.
- The property is located at an elevation of 2,000 feet (above the fog line), featuring rich volcanic soils and unique microclimates particularly favorable for Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Vineyard clearing began in the late 1970's
- During the clearing process, old redwood hand split grape stakes spaced at 1x1 meter intervals were discovered, reconfirming the notion that the property had once been a prime viticulture area dating back to the late 1870's.
- The first Schweiger vines were planted in 1981. The first harvest was 1984.
- For the first 10 years, the Schweiger family sold their fruit to Cafaro Cellars, ZD, Newton and Stags Leap Winery.
- In 1994, Schweiger Vineyards became a bonded winery and the family began bottling wine under their own label, though they continued to sell most of their grapes to contracted wineries.
- Winemaker, Andrew Schweiger, is a graduate of the UC Davis Viticulture and Enology program. Before coming to Schweiger Vineyards, he worked with several prestigious wineries including Chateau St. Jean, ZD Wines, Joseph Phelps Vineyards, Trefethen Vineyards and Can Cellars.
- As production increased, construction began in 2000 to add an additional square feet to the winery. In 2001, construction completed on the fermentation room and in 2002, the garden terrace was completed.
- Today, Schweiger Vineyards includes 25 acres of cabernet, four acres of chardonnay, two acres of merlot and micro blocks of Cabernet Franc, Malbec & Petite Sirah . Schweiger also produces a Sauvignon Blanc with fruit sourced from Sonoma County.
- Annual harvest yields vary from 1.5 to 3.5 tons per acre.
- The solar array at Schweiger Vineyards produces enough electricity daily to power the entire winery operation and produces clean electricity that goes back into the power grid.
