WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Opens with an aromatic tapestry of bing cherry, raspberry preserves, and soft vanilla, underscored by whispers of toasted oak and wet forest floor. Its velvety tannins glide into a moderate-weight mid-palate, culminating in a layered finish of dried cranberries and hibiscus, woven with evolved tannins.

PAIRING IDEAS

This expressive, nuanced wine is a sublime match for roasted duck with cherry glaze, herb-crusted turkey, or pork chops with a soy-ginger marinade.
